<p>Michigan State University Alumni Association</p>	<p>26-Feb-10</p>	<p>Five \$1,500 scholarships are available for students who plan to attend MSU for the 2010-2011 academic year. Students who apply must be accepted for MSU admission. Criteria for selection includes: grade point average, test scores, positive recommendations from teachers and/or counselor, and the applicants' written comments on the application. Grade point average should be 3.5 or higher ALTHOUGH consideration may be given to students with slightly lower averages.</p>
<p>The Grand Traverse Area Retired School Personnel Academic Scholarship</p>	<p>26-Feb-10</p>	<p>A student should have a minimum GPA of 3.5 on a 4.0 scale, must have a composite of 1100 on the SAT or an ACT composite of 27, must be planning to attend a college or university with the goal of earning a baccalaureate degree, should be involved in high school activities and/or outside activities such as employment or community service. Students who wish to apply for this scholarship MUST submit three GTARSP recommendation forms; one from a counselor, one from a faculty member and one from a personal reference (not a family member). Applications and recommendation forms are located in the guidance office.</p>
<p>The Grand Traverse Area Retired School Personnel Vocational Scholarship</p>	<p>26-Feb-10</p>	<p>A student should present an overall GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale. A student may apply if he or she is planning to enroll in a non-baccalaureate degree program and has a specific vocational goal. A student must submit three completed GTARSP recommendation forms: one from a counselor, one from another faculty member and one from a personal reference (not a family member). A student must provide some evidence of his or her specific achievement within the chosen field.</p>

<p>Munson Health Careers Scholarship</p>	<p>3/6/2010 UPDATED!!!!</p>	<p>Students who wish to apply for this scholarship should be a resident of Grand Traverse, Wexford or Antrim counties for a period of at least 6 months prior to application. You must be pursuing a health-related program of study in an accredited college or university. You must provide a recent transcript verifying a minimum GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale. ESSAYS hold a lot of weight so have someone review your answers before sending them into the committee. Good luck.</p>
<p>American Legion Eagle Scout of the Year</p>	<p>1-Mar-10</p>	<p>Eligible students must be registered members of a Boy Scout Troop, Varsity Scout Team, or Venturing Crew chartered to an American Legion Post, American Legion Auxiliary Unit or Sons of the American Legion squadron -OR- be a registered, active member of a chartered Boy Scout Troop, Varsity Scout Team, or Venturing Crew, and the son or grandson of a Legionnaire or Auxiliary member -AND- received the Eagle Scout Award, be an active member of his religious institution and must have received the appropriate Boy Scout Religious emblem, have demonstrated practical citizenship in church, school, scouting, and community, and be at least 15 years old at the time of selection.</p>
<p>Eastern Michigan University Alumni Association Scholarship</p>	<p>5-Mar-10</p>	<p>The award granted for this scholarship is \$1,250 per academic year and may be renewed for four consecutive years for a maximum of \$5,000. Applicants must be admitted to the University and have a minimum GPA of 3.2 or higher. All applicants must provide a scholarship application, a written recommendation from a teacher and/or counselor, an official transcript which includes ACT/SAT awards and write a 250 word essay stating why he/she is uniquely qualified for this award. A parent or grandparent who is an EMU alumna/alumnus must sponsor applicants. Candidates may be asked to attend an interview with the scholarship committee. Pick up an application in the guidance office.</p>

<p>Scholar Athlete Milk Mustache of the year (Sammy) 2010 Award Program</p>	<p>5-Mar-10</p>	<p>The SAMMY Award program recognizes outstanding senior scholar athletes throughout the US. From now until March 5, coaches, principals, guidance counselors, athletic directors, parents and relatives are encouraged to nominate a student athlete for this award. Students are also encouraged to nominate themselves for this award. Judging will be based on academic performance, athletic excellence, leadership, and community service. Scholarship awards will ONLY be granted to students attending a MICHIGAN College or University. This scholarship is available for students who plan to continue their education in medical careers. DOCUMENTATION must be provided, please stop by the guidance office to pick up the specific requirements.</p>

Scholarship awards will ONLY be granted to students attending a MICHIGAN College or University. Applicants will be judged on financial need and scholastic standing.</p>

<p>American Legion Auxiliary National President's Scholarship</p>	<p>15-Mar-10</p>	<p>Candidates shall be daughters, granddaughters, great grand daughters, sons, grandsons, great grand sons of honorable discharged or deceased men or women veterans of WWI, WWII, Korean Conflict, Vietnam Hostilities, Grenada and Lebanon Hostilities, Panama Hostilities, and or the Persian Gulf. Applicant for this scholarship must complete 50 hours of community service and show documentation. Stop by the guidance office for more specific details.</p>
