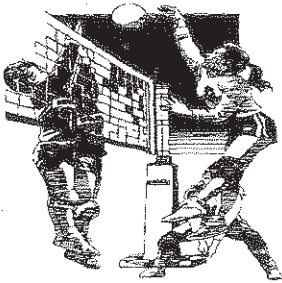


Team Camp June 24th and 25th

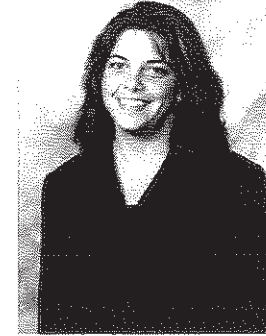

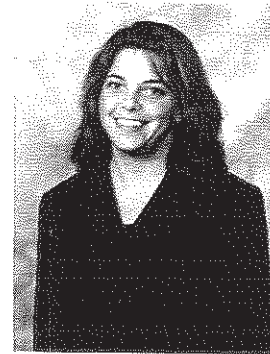
